 May 13	Party Affiliation Change Deadline	Registered voter party affiliation declaration/change deadline; new voters may still declare a party affiliation when registering after this deadline
 May 14	Candidate Filing Period Begins	Candidates for state, county, and municipal offices may begin filing today
 May 29	Candidate Filing Period Ends	Final day for candidates to file for state, county, and municipal offices
 July 2	Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) Primary Election Absentee Voting Begins	Absentee voting begins for Uniformed and Overseas Citizens in the Wyoming Primary Election (UOCAVA voters may request a ballot at any time in 2026 prior to August 18, 2026) visit sos.wyo.gov/elections for info
 July 21	Primary Election In-Person Absentee (Early) Voting Begins	In-person absentee (early) voting begins for the Wyoming Primary Election; check your county clerk's website for location details and times
 August 3	Mail-In Voter Registration Deadline (Primary Election)	Last day to register to vote by mail for the primary election. Voters may still register in person and cast an absentee ballot (early voting) from August 4-August 17
 August 18	Primary Election Day	Voters nominate candidates for the General Election in November (in-person only); new voters may register to vote at their polling place on Primary Election Day—review acceptable forms of identification first

 September 18	Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) General Election Absentee Voting Begins	Absentee voting begins for Uniformed and Overseas Citizens in the Wyoming General Election (UOCAVA voters may request a ballot at any time in 2026 prior to November 3, 2026) visit sos.wyo.gov/elections for info
 October 6	General Election In-Person Absentee (Early) Voting Begins	In-person absentee (early) voting begins for the Wyoming General Election; check your county clerk's website for polling locations and times
 October 19	Mail-In Voter Registration Deadline for the Wyoming General Election	Last day to register to vote by mail for the Wyoming General Election; voters may still register in person and cast an absentee (early) ballot from October 20-November 2
 November 3	General Election Day	Polls are open from 7:00 AM-7:00 PM; check your county clerk's website for polling locations; new voters may register to vote at their polling place on General Election Day—review acceptable forms of identification first

Per Wyoming Statute, proof of citizenship and Wyoming residency is required to register to vote; identification is required when voting whether by absentee ballot, in-person absentee (early) voting, or on Primary/General Election Day.
